## MOTH (YP) (Male/Female, Age 9-14)

Vocal Range: Flexible

One of the fairies ordered by Titania to attend Bottom after Titania falls in love with him.

## MUSTARDSEED (YP) (Male/Female, Age 9-14)

One of the fairies ordered by Titania to attend Bottom after Titania falls in love with him.

## CHANGELING (YP) (Male/Female, Age 7-10)

Non-Singing Role

A child, stolen from an Indian king, and given to Titania's care. This child is the subject of the epic argument between Oberon and Titania.
